The Delafield Farmers' Market is a producer-only market. Only locally grown, in-season produce and flowers and locally made arts and/or crafts from Wisconsin may be sold at the Farmers' Market. No wholesale loads of produce may be marketed. The market manager and board reserves the right to make vendor inspections at the location where produce and products are grown, produced, or crafted. The Market Manager and Board reserve the right to limit the number of same type vendors and to restrict items for sale that are deemed inappropriate. Applying vendors will be invited to participate based upon the need for their product.

Market Season: Saturdays, May 6 through October 28, 2023

Market Hours: 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Market Location: Delafield Sports Complex Parking Lot (Please note change for 2023 season)

LICENSES/PERMITS/INSURANCE

- All vendors must obtain and comply with all applicable federal, state, and local regulations.
- All vendors must obtain and give the market manager copies of any necessary licensure or permits. For further assistance, please contact the Waukesha County Environmental Health Department at 262-896-8300. Another contact would be Brian Joarta at DATCP (Cell: 608-215-4042). **Applications submitted without these documents, if necessary, may not be considered.**
- All vendors are strongly encouraged to provide copies of personal and product liability insurance.

MISSED MARKET DAY

Any vendor that is not able to be at the market on a date they are signed up for needs to call or text Denise Whitmore at 262-409-5276 as soon as they become aware of the situation.

VENDOR SPACES AND COST

A single vendor stall is approximately 13 feet in width. If you have specific needs, please indicate this on the application form.

Whole Season Rate: \$120.00 per stall

Daily Rate (if available): \$20.00 per Market

TENT ANCHORS

Any vendor bringing a canopy (tent) must provide the appropriate amount of weight to keep the tent from being blown over in windy weather.

SCALES

Any scales used must be approved commercial scales and certified annually by DATCP Weights and Measures. The telephone number to call is 920-397-2273.

PANDEMIC

Because of the uncertainty of the situation, any responses to this are unknown at this time. Any needed information will be issued when it is needed.

TRASH MANAGEMENT

All vendors are expected to pick up all their trash and debris when leaving at the end of the market day.

SET UP AND TAKE DOWN TIMES

Vendors are not allowed to set up before 7 am and not allowed to take down before 1 pm, unless by special permission from the market manager.

CBD Oil and Products Containing CBD

No CBD oil or products containing CBD are allowed to be sold at the market or talked about until the state and federal regulations for said products are more defined.
